A foolish son is ruin to his father, and wife's quarreling is a continual dripping of rain.

(19:13)

It is better to live in a corner of the housetop than in a house shared with a quarrelsome wife.

(21:9)

It is better to live in a desert land than with a quarrelsome and fretful woman.

(21:19)

Three things are too wonderful for me; four I do not understand: the way of an eagle in the sky, the way of a serpent on a rock, the way of a ship on the high seas, and the way of a man with a virgin.

30:18-19

#1: Husbands and Wives: Keep Your <u>Covenant</u> and Treasure Your <u>Companion</u> (2:16-17)

So you will be delivered from forbidden woman, from the adulteress with her smooth words, who forsakes the companion of her youth and forgets the covenant with her God (2:16-17)

This is my beloved and this is my friend Songs 5:16

An excellent wife is the **crown** of her husband, but she who brings shame is like **rottenness** in his bones.

Proverbs 12:4

House and wealth are inherited from fathers, but a prudent wife is from the Lord. Proverbs 19:14

He who finds a wife finds a good thing and obtains favor from the Lord. Proverbs 18:22

#2: Mothers and Fathers: <u>Teach</u> and <u>Discipline</u> Your Children Together (1:8; 6:20; 29:15)

The rod and reproof give wisdom, but a child left to himself brings shame to his mother.

Prov 29:15

Hear my son, your father's instruction and forsake not your mother's teaching...

Proverbs 1:8

My son, keep your father's commandment, and forsake not your mother's teaching

Proverbs 6:20

Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him.

(13:24)

Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of discipline drives it far from him.

(22:15)

Do not withhold discipline from a child; if you strike him with a rod, he will not die. If you strike him with a rod, you will save his soul from Sheol.

Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart.

(29:17)

#3: Children: Bring <u>Joy</u> to Your Mother and Father by Living Wisely (10:1; 15:20; 29:3)

A wise son makes a glad father, but a foolish son is a sorrow to his mother Proverbs 10:1

A wise son makes a glad father, but a foolish man despises his mother.

Prov 15:20

He who loves wisdom makes his father glad, but a companion of prostitutes squanders his wealth.

Prov 29:3

#4: Siblings: Be United and Be Supportive (17:17; 18:24)

A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. (17:17)

A man of many companions may come to ruin, but there is friend who sticks closer than a brother.

18:24

#5: Concerning the Fatherless and the Widow: <u>Love</u> and <u>Protect</u> Them in God-Honoring Ways (15:25; 23:10-11)

The Lord tears down the house of the proud but maintains he widow's boundaries.

Prov 15:25

Do not move an ancient landmark or enter the fields of the fatherless, for their Redeemer is strong; he will plead their cause against you.

23:10-11
