## QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Where is one area you see the brokenness of the world every day? Why does this stand out to you?

2. How are people both "oppressed and oppressors, victims and perpetrators"? Is this true for everyone? How does this shape the way we treat people as those who are sent into the world?

3. Matthew summarizes Jesus' ministry with 3 words. What are they and what do they mean? Which do you tend to gravitate towards? Which do you tend to ignore?

4. How does Jesus' response to the people challenge you?

5. Jesus sees, feels, and acts in light of the hurting crowds. What might it look like for you to reflect his heart in one of these ways?

6. Why do you think God chooses to use prayer to mobilize him to send laborers? What steps can you take to incorporate this prayer into your prayer life?

7. Praying for laborers often opens our eyes to the harvest field we are called to. Where has God called you to labor? Who has he put in your path that you can pray for, share Christ, and serve?
