QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Icebreaker: Has anyone had any type of interaction with sheep? If so tell us about it? What did you notice about the sheep?
2. Tony described an intimate, two-way relationship between the Good Shepherd and His flock. How well do you know Him? What prevents you from knowing Him in a deeper way?
3. "The Shepherd knows his sheep, and they know him and follow him." Would anyone be willing to share how they came to know and follow the Shepherd?
4. The Good Shepherd knows His sheep. When we stray, he calls us back. When was a time when you strayed and He called you back?
5. The thief comes to steal and kill and destroy. How can we guard against the thief/false shepherds?
6. Tony said that the Good Shepherd is not merely willing to risk his life, but to lay it down. What is the difference between these two? How should it shape our view of Jesus as the Good Shepherd?
7. Tony said, "You need a flock!" Why is being in community a necessity for you, personally? Why do we sometimes drift away from community? What intentional step do you need to take to live in community?
8. What is something that you learned or that stood out to you about God as the Good Shepherd? Why is this significant? How does this truth change us?
