QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. ICE BREAKER: Can you recall a time in your life when someone in authority over you (e.g. a boss, pastor, legislator, etc.) did something seemingly “beneath” them in service to others? If so, what stood out to you about this act?
2. In verse 1 of chapter 13, what is John getting at when he states that “Jesus loved His own [and us by extension] to the end [or completely or always]”?
3. Read Romans 8:35-39. From this text, what stands out to you about the love of Christ? How does it connect with our John 13 passage?
4. Why is Jesus uniquely qualified to cleanse us from our sin? What else do we sometimes run to in order to cleanse our sins?
5. How did Jesus washing the disciples’ feet demonstrate His redemptive mission? What’s one practical way you can obey the call to wash others’ feet?
6. Even though we as believers have been justified by Christ, why do we need to practice daily confession of our sin before Him?
7. What practical truths can we learn from the hypocrisy of Judas and the ultimate shipwreck of his faith? How can we guard against walking in his footsteps?
8. As a growth group, how can we encourage one another to live humble lives of service?
9. Are there any other truths that you learned from this text? Are there any other ways in which we can apply it as a growth group?
