QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. Have you ever been betrayed by someone close to you? If so, how did that make you feel?
- 2. Read Hebrews 4:14-16. How should the reality of a Savior who can sympathize with us encourage us?
- 3. What are some practical ways that we can model Jesus's response to betrayal?
- 4. How can we help unbelievers understand that they are not beyond the love of Christ?
- 5. What are some practical ways that we can guard ourselves from following Judas's example of hypocrisy?
- 6. Why does the relationship between the cross and glory seem paradoxical to the world? Why should this relationship, specifically the idea of glory after suffering, lead us to rejoice?
- 7. Why was Jesus uniquely qualified to die on our behalf for our salvation?
- 8. In verse 34 of this chapter, Jesus commands us to love one another just as He has loved us. What are some practical ways that we can demonstrate this selfless love?
- 10. Are there any other truths that you learned from this text? Are there any other ways in which we can apply it as a growth group?
