“Heavenly Truths for Troubled Hearts”

QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Tony began his sermon by quoting Don Piper's *90 Minutes in Heaven*, and he explains that Piper has a view of heaven from first-hand experience. Why do you think heaven is so intriguing to both believers and non-believers?
2. Tony references Job 14:1 and brings up the types of trouble we can face (*social troubles, disappointments, circumstances, seasons of great trouble, spiritual turmoil, trouble when you obey God*). Which of these can you most relate to, and how can we come alongside you as a growth group to encourage you and love you?
3. Why does Jesus reference his Father 22 times in this passage? How does the Father speak to the disciples' fears/troubles?
4. Even on the eve of his betrayal and death, Jesus comforts his disciples. What is the connection between the cross and our comfort in Jesus? How can the cross be a source of comfort for any recurring anxieties in your life?
5. What can this passage teach us about ourselves as sinners? What can it teach us about ourselves as Christ-followers?
6. This text challenges us to pray. What prayers can you be praying in light of Jesus' words in John 14?
7. What else might it look like for us to respond to this passage in our everyday lives?
8. How can this passage inform our witness to the lost? Is there anyone you know that would benefit from hearing the message of this text?
