“Keep Calm and Love Jesus”

QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Jesus is preparing the disciples for his departure—encouraging them to remain calm. How might this sense of calmness shape our own lives and walks with Jesus?
2. Love is important in this passage and sermon. How do we see this theme of love displayed in this passage?
3. How does Jesus' directions for love challenge some of our and our culture's definitions of love? Are there any areas of your life that the Spirit is convicting you to love Jesus by keeping his commandments?
4. How can we find comfort in the Holy Spirit's indwelling presence? In what situations does his presence bring comfort?
5. Tony said, "The Holy Spirit will come and fulfill the role Jesus has been fulfilling." What is your reaction to that? How does this shape how we see the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives?
6. How is the peace that Jesus gives (v. 27) different from the peace we try to find in the world? Where do people (ourselves included!) often try to go to get peace?
7. Jesus talks about his Father a lot in this text. What do we learn about the character of God?
8. (Consider asking a few volunteers...) What does it look like for you, specifically, to apply and respond to this text?
