QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. (v.20) Jesus clearly has a Great Commission mindset as he prays for the disciples yet to be made. How might our prayers be different if we had a vision like Jesus for those yet to believe?
2. (v.21) How does the unity of our Growth Group (or church) reflect the unity of the Father and the Son? How would the "oneness" of our group persuade or dissuade unbelievers? How can we further develop and display the oneness Christ prayed for?
3. (v.22) What is the "glory" that the Father gave the Son, that he gives to us? How does it contribute to our oneness?
4. (v.23) Why is being one with our brothers & sisters in Christ such a powerful apologetic? What does it mean to be identified by the world as the people God loves?
5. (v. 24) Jesus said his Father loved him before the foundation of the world. What does this tell us about who Jesus is? What does it tell us about the plan of God? How can this truth encourage our faith today?
6. (v. 25) Jesus laments that the world doesn't know the Father. How does this reminder affect us when we are frustrated or angry at things around us? How does it motivate us to action?
7. (v.26) What name of God has Jesus made known to us? Why does he continue to make it known?
8. Is there anything else from the sermon or text that stuck out to you? Are there any specific action steps you need to follow in obedience to Christ from this sermon/text?
