QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Pilate asked, "What is truth?" But we're confronted with that question in every temptation we face. How do we continually convince ourselves of God truth when we're tempted to believe Satan's lies?
2. Jesus reminded us that this was all happening under the sovereign hand of his Father. How does that change how we see our life's circumstances?
3. Jesus said his kingdom is not of this world. What does it mean, then, to live in this world and, yet, be part of his kingdom? How does his kingdom shape our worldview?
4. What is something that you learned or that stood out to you from this sermon/text? Why is it significant?
5. What can this passage teach or show us about God (consider Father, Son, and Spirit)?
6. What can this passage teach or show us about ourselves?
7. What should it look like for you to respond to this sermon/text (e.g., in worship, obedience, repentance, etc.)?
