QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Ice Breaker: Tony said this passage is intended to give us closure. Is there a show, story, or movie you have seen that has left you without closure?
2. This “Epilogue” to the book of John details Peter’s restoration. Why are stories of redemption and restoration, like Tiger Woods winning the Masters, so powerful universally?
3. How can the power of the redemption and restoration theme in the Bible, and this passage, impact our everyday evangelism and missions?
4. What does Peter's restoration show us about Jesus?
5. John goes to great lengths to humanize the disciples and Jesus. Have you ever seen them this way? How can this impact how you read the Bible and share the Word with others?
6. Jesus’ foundational question to Peter was “Do You Love Me?” This is still to be the foundation of all we do. What are some things, even good things, that get in the way of us simply *loving God*? How can you go back to the basics of loving Him this week?
7. How do you need to grow in our calling to care for one another?
8. “Your failure hasn’t put you beyond the reach of Jesus’ restoring grace”. Shame and failure are universal. How can this impact your discipleship with one another and your evangelism this week?
9. How does the realization that loving Jesus isn’t past tense but a present reality change how you see your own love for Him?
