QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. What were your highs and lows from the summer? What evidences of God's grace can you identify?
2. Why do we sometimes feel a tension between the Great Commission and the Great Commandment? How can these two go together?
3. Tony said, "God deals with everyone with either deserved judgment or undeserved grace." How does this shape our interactions with lost friends, neighbors, coworkers, etc.?
4. Tony said all we need to speak is God's Word and God's Spirit (cf. Micah 3:8). What might this look like for those who aren't preachers or pastors?
5. Micah preached for a long time without seeing any fruit. Are there any areas of faithfulness you feel like you've worked at for a long time and not seen fruit? How can we avoid despair in those times?
6. Tony identified 3 motivations for covenant faithfulness from Micah. What were they (*answer: creation, redemption, and new creation*), and how does each motivate us to pursue justice, mercy, and humility (cf. Micah 6:8)?
7. Which aspects of Micah 6:6-8 do you feel particularly drawn towards, and why? Which aspects are hardest for you, and why?
8. As we start a new semester of GG gatherings, what particular ways can we as a GG pursue Micah 6:6-8?
