QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. ICE-BREAKER: Verse 7 encourages us to abound in thanksgiving. After reading this text and hearing this sermon, what are you thankful for?
- 2. Walter warned against defining ourselves by what we avoid, instead of being those who are defined by being for Christ. At any point in your life, have you defined yourself by what you were against, rather than being for Christ?
- 3. Common grace allows good ideas to come apart from Christian community, but truth will still accord with Christ. What is something that you have learned from a non-Christian source, yet found that it aligned with biblical truth?
- 4. To "walk" is to both know and do. What practices can we put into place to help us foster both of those aspects? What can we do to know God better? What practices will help us "do" better?
- 5. Walter explained that being "free in Christ" does not mean being an isolated Christian. How can we as a GG encourage each other in our freedom while also protecting one another from being allured by things of this world?
- 6. The application of this sermon to the unbeliever was that "Christ is enough!" How does this specific text help you to articulate this truth to a lost person?
