QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Verse 1 says, “Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven.” What are some ways we can constantly remind ourselves of the immense blessing of our forgiveness?
2. Christians often fall into a trap of pretending to be better than we actually are.
 - a. Do you feel like you struggle with this temptation?
 - b. What steps can we take as a group to help create an environment of honesty, where we feel no need to pretend?
3. We know that God will forgive our sins, so why do we so often hold onto them?
4. Is there unconfessed sin in your life that you would like to confess publicly?
5. This text contains a promise of forgiveness for both believers and unbelievers.
 - a. Why is this such an important message to the unbeliever?
 - b. Why should this promise give us confidence to evangelize the lost?
 - c. Why is this promise so important to the Christian?
