QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. Peter tells us that we must live out our identity in a corrupt world.
 - a. Which aspect of our new identity sticks out to you most from this first chapter? ("children" (14), "called" (15), able to call God "Father" (17), "ransomed" (18), "purified souls" (22), "born again" (23)).
 - b. What are the barriers that may try to keep you from living out your identity in this world?
- 2. Pastor Tony said, "Many never feel good about themselves; and constantly seek approval from others... You will always have insecurity issues as long as you fail to believe what God says about you."
 - a. How is God's perspective of you different from your own perspective of yourself?
 - b. How is God's perspective of you different from others' perspective of you?
 - c. How should your new identity, spoken of in this chapter, inform how you think and feel about yourself?
- 3. Pastor Tony spoke of the importance of spending time with God every day.
 - a. Recently, how have your personal times with the Lord been (in prayer, in the Word, in meditation on Him, etc.)?
 - b. What are the possible barriers that could keep you from maintaining regular times with the Lord?
 - c. What practices have you put into place that help you better spend time with the Lord daily?
