

## Discipleship Tools

In a season of live streaming and canceled children's programs, may the following questions and activities guide you in helping your children apply the sermon.

### Sermon Discussion

#### Preschool

1. Do you know what a cornerstone (or foundation) is? Why do you think the Bible says Jesus is the cornerstone?
2. What is something that makes you feel special? Do you know that you are special to God and he has a plan for you?

#### Younger Kids

1. What does it mean to be a living stone? Why is Jesus called a cornerstone?
2. How can we offer living sacrifices to God?
3. Have you considered that you are chosen and precious to God? How does this change the way you think about yourself?
4. How does being a child of God change our purpose in this life?

#### Older Kids

1. Why are we called living stones and Jesus called the cornerstone?
2. Why is it important to build our lives on Jesus? What are some things we might be tempted to build our lives on instead of Jesus?
3. Have you ever felt like you are not important? How does knowing that everyone who is in Christ is a chosen person for God's possession and part of a royal priesthood make you feel?
4. For what purpose has God saved us? How can you live out your purpose this week?

### Christ Connection

How does this text point us to Jesus?

*Preschool:* Jesus wants us to build our lives on Him.

*Elementary:* We can know who we are and our purpose in life when we place our identity in Jesus and build our lives around Him.

### Activity

#### Preschool

#### Build with Legos or Blocks

Talk about how Jesus is the cornerstone or the foundation of a new temple-the church. Each time a person accepts Jesus as their Savior its like a block is added.

#### Elementary

#### Cup Stacking/House of Cards Competition

What you will need: Plastic Cups or a Deck of Cards

Have each family member build a structure from plastic cups or cards. Turn on a fan to see if anyones house will stand! If it does, it's probably because it had a good foundation. Talk about how Jesus is the one solid foundation we can build our lives on.
