Sermon Discussion

Preschool

1. What are some things that you know to be true about God?
2. Can you think of a time when you were promised something good? How did it feel? What are some things God has promised His people?
3. What tools has God given you to help you live a life that glorifies Him?

Elementary

4. What do you know to be true about the character of God? How is knowing God personally different than just knowing about God?
5. When do you have a hard time obeying your parents? How can God help you?
6. Can you think of a time when you were promised something good? How did it feel? How can God's promises help us?

Christ Connection

How does this text point us to Jesus?

Preschool: We can have a new life because Jesus died for us and rose again!

Elementary: We can trust in the promises of God and have a new life through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Activity

Buddy Guide

When you trust someone you believe in their honesty and reliability. God has proven faithful throughout scripture. He wants us to trust Him.

Create an obstacle course with a prize at the end. Blindfold your child. Tell your child they will have to trust you to make it through the obstacle course safely to the end where they will receive their prize. You can either walk them through the course holding their hand or stand at the other side and call out instructions.

Afterwards, relate the activity to how we can't always see what God is doing but we can trust in Him and His promises. *God is faithful, He will do what he says he will do.*

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
