## **QUESTIONS**

*(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)*

1. ICE-BREAKER: Pastor Tony mentioned that hearing and remembering the basics of the gospel should never get old to a Christian. What thing, from your everyday life, do you never get tired of hearing?
2. In this passage, Peter is intending to “stir up” his readers by reminding them of the gospel.
  - a. As a growth group, how can we stir each other up?
  - b. What practices can you put into place to keep your affections for God from cooling?
  - c. Pastor Tony said, “It is possible to know Bible facts, but not be awed by the God of the Bible!” What can you do to help your Bible reading (and other disciplines) lead you more into an awe and love for God?
3. This passage serves as a reminder about the truth of Christ’s return. How does confidence in Christ return encourage you to live a more godly life daily?
