QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1) This passage calls readers to be diligent in reflecting the purity of Christ.
 - a. What actions or practices could you add to your life to help you better reflect Christ’s purity?
 - b. What actions or practices could you remove or limit to help you better reflect Christ’s purity?

- 2) Pastor Tony encouraged us to experience the peace of Christ, personally with Christ and relationally with others.
 - a. In our modern culture of disagreement and division (politics, racial issues, ethical questions.), what does it look like for the Church to live at peace with others?
 - b. What is, or isn’t, peace in our modern culture? Do we have to 100% agree with a person in order to bear with them, forgive them, or live in harmony with them?
 - c. How does our peace with Christ encourage and empower our peace with others?
 - d. Let us spend a few minutes in a concentrated time in prayer as a group in light of the various tensions in our culture, for the unity of the church, and for our witness to the gospel.

- 3) As this is the end of 2 Peter, what themes or ideas stand out to you about this letter? In what ways were you most challenged by this letter? How did this sermon series help you to better follow Jesus?
