QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1) What is the difference between love that is “genuine” (or “without hypocrisy”) and love that is not? (12:9)
- 2) What are some ways we can avoid becoming “slothful in zeal”? (12:11)
- 3) Verse 15 commands us to “rejoice with those who rejoice” and “weep with those who weep?” Which is easier for you to do and why?
- 4) Pastor Tony mentioned how countercultural the commands in this passage would have been in the first century.
 - a. Which of these commands do you find to be the most countercultural today?
 - b. Which of these commands seem to be the most absent from modern Christianity?
 - c. Which of these commands are the hardest for you to obey in your own life?
