QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1) Let's spend some time “embracing the world in prayer”
 - a. Who are some people who you may have an opportunity to share the gospel with this week? As a group, pray for them by name.
 - b. Pray for our eyes to be open to opportunities around you. Pray for opportunities to connect with neighbors, co-workers, and people in your networks.
 - c. Pray for the spread of the gospel around the world (maybe spend time praying for specific IDC missionaries).
- 2) Verse 1-2 instructs believers to pray for leaders. Let's spend a few minutes praying for our newly elected leaders.
- 3) This passage moves from prayer to engaging the world with the gospel.
 - a. Why is prayer a necessary component of evangelism and missions?
 - b. What is the danger of sharing the gospel un-prayerfully?
 - c. How does prayer spur us onto missions? And how does missions motivate us to pray?
- 4) Why should the exclusivity of the gospel (“there is one God and there is one mediator between God and man” verse 5) spur us onto missions and evangelism?
