“Grateful Obedience”

QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1) Looking back on God’s faithfulness should motivate us to personal faithfulness in the present.
 - a. What practices do you keep that help you to remember His faithfulness to you?
 - b. How does living in a church community help us to better remember God’s faithfulness?
- 2) Verses 3-5 recounts the ways the LORD intervened to bring blessings to his people. Would anyone like to share a story of a time that the LORD intervened and brought blessing through a difficult situation?
- 3) Verses 6-7 asks what offering we must bring for our transgressions (sacrifices of quality, sacrifices of quantity, sacrifice of first born). But, we see that what God requires is to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly.
 - a. Why is it easier for us to think about paying for our own sins through gifts and sacrifices, than accepting that Christ paid for our transgressions?
 - b. Why should the truth of Christ’s payment of our sins motivate us to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly?
- 4) Verse 8 commands us to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with God.
 - a. What would happen if you attempted to do one of those without the others (i.e. trying to do justice without showing kindness or without humility)?
 - b. Which of those three commands is the easiest/most natural for you to follow?
 - c. Which of those three commands is the most difficult for you to follow?
