“Transformation Through Beholding”

QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. How would you describe the “ministry of death” to an unbeliever? Said differently, what is the purpose of the Law?
2. Pastor Tony encouraged us to “Wake up daily and think about what God has done for you in Christ!”
 - a. What practices do you have in place to remember what God has done for you?
 - b. How does looking back at His faithfulness motivate you to do great things for God?
3. The gospel brings confident hope (v. 12).
 - a. How does the hope we have that Jesus wins in the end, give us boldness in the present?
 - b. This boldness, however, does not have to mean rudeness. What is the difference between being bold in the gospel and being rude?
4. “Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.” (V. 17). The Spirit brings freedom *from* certain things and *for* certain purposes.
 - a. What does the Spirit of the Lord give freedom from? (possible answers: sin, condemnation, fear, unnecessary toil, etc.).
 - b. What is our freedom in the Spirit for? (possible answers: we are free from sin to serve God and His people, we are free to do good works, free to rest in God’s sacrifice for us, etc.)
5. Pastor Tony said “Beholding leads to becoming” and “You become like what you worship”.
 - a. What does the world say brings about change (possible answers: time, experience, self-help books, moralism, positivity).
 - b. What does the Bible, and verse 18, say brings change? (possible answers: The Spirit, beholding God’s glory, Christ, God’s Word, the Gospel).
