QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. ICEBREAKER: Do you have a story about a camping trip that did not go as planned? (i.e., Tent was blown over in the middle of the night, bear crashed your campsite, etc.)
2. In what ways might our positive view of death as Christians influence the way we share the hope of Christ with those who are far from God?
3. How can we balance our longing for the glorious life to come and our call to participate in the mission of God in the world here and now?
4. How does the reality that you will have a new body and will be "at home with the Lord" bring you encouragement in your daily life? How can we as a group make a practice of regularly encouraging one another's faith with these truths?
5. Tony said, "This future (new bodies, new creation, the presence of Jesus) should energize our lives now, and cause us to make this life count." In what specific ways are you making this life count in light of your future as a Christian?
