QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. What are potential barriers to a cross-shaped ministry? How can we overcome these barriers? How can we as a group play a role in seeing this happen in one another's lives?
- 2. Why do you think we so often confuse timidity and gentleness? How might seeing gentleness as an outflow of cross-shaped ministry help us better understand the difference?
- 3. Daniel said, "So as we pursue cross-shaped ministry, let's be sure we're not fighting the wrong battles with the wrong weapons."
 - What might be some of the "wrong weapons" that we employ in our fight against all that desires to distract us from cross-shaped ministry?
 - Which of the items on Daniel's list of "spiritual weapons" most impresses itself upon you as needed in this fight?
 - His list consisted of... Faith, Hope, Love, Forgiveness, Righteousness, Truth (found in God's Word), Prayer, the Gospel, our weakness is a weapon as God glorifies himself through us
- 4. How might a vision of cross-shaped ministry help us boldly fulfill our ministry as ambassadors of Christ?
- 5. Daniel said, "Cross-shaped ministry has a missional pulse. How can we claim to be shaped by the cross if we're not reaching out to more and more people who need the cross?"
 - Why is this such an important concept to hold on to? Why are we most likely to lose our missional pulse in our pursuit of a cross-shaped ministry?
 - o How can we as a group ensure this does not happen? What steps can we take or rhythms can we establish?
