QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Opener: What's one thing you've lost in life that you'd most like to get back? How would your life change if you got it back?
2. Jesus tells these stories in the presence of both "tax collectors and sinners" (v.1) and "Pharisees and scribes" (v.2). How does Jesus relate to each group? How can you try to imitate Jesus in these interactions?
3. What is repentance, and how should we practice it regularly? What are some barriers to us regularly repenting? How can we help one another live lives of repentance?
4. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus rejoices in your repentance and faith (vv.6-7, 9-10)? How can that shape your ongoing life of following Jesus?
5. Tony mentioned 6 principles to help with our evangelism from this passage (Time, Wisdom, Truth, Inspiration, Hope, and Church).
6. Which of these did you find particularly helpful and applicable?
7. Let's identify grace in one another—who do you know that seems to model faithfulness in one of these areas? Encourage them now, or make a plan to encourage them later if they aren't in this group.
