QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Why was Jesus's entrance into Jerusalem so jarring for the community? What was its significance?
2. What are some ways that Jesus demonstrates his divine control in this passage? What are some areas of life that you are currently trying to be in control over?
3. Tony highlighted how we could learn from the donkey's owner in how he allowed Jesus to use his donkey without hesitation. How is this interaction similar to the stewardship of the minas from our sermon last week (Luke 19:11-27)? What are some areas of your life that you hesitate to surrender to the Lord?
4. What does Jesus's emotion over the city of Jerusalem reveal about his character? How have you experienced this compassion in your own life? How could having this heart posture impact the way we engage in mission in our city?
5. The scene of Jesus in the temple reflects his heart for zealous and appropriate worship. What are some barriers in your life that hinder you from prioritizing worship in this way?
6. When Jesus references Isaiah 57:6, he is communicating that the temple is supposed to be a place for all people. What steps can we take on Sunday mornings to make IDC a place of worship for all people/anyone who walks through the doors? Is there anything specific that you can do?
7. Last week, we reviewed the unique role and responsibilities of the elders at Imago Dei. What are some of the unique obligations of covenant members at IDC? In what ways is membership at Imago Dei church "meaningful"?
