## QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. Tony mentioned parables being "stories that pack a punch." What do you think is the main theme that Jesus is trying to communicate through this parable?
- 2. What does it look like to be faithful in the face of opposition? What are some examples from your own life when you have had to do this?
- 3. Tony mentioned that our "view of Jesus impacts everything." What are some ways we can subtly begin to view Jesus incorrectly, and how can that affect us? Would anyone be willing to share how they've had to correct their view of Jesus?
- 4. What are the tasks/responsibilities ("minas") we have been called to be faithful with?
- 5. As we spend the next month or so considering our commitment to this church and meditating over the covenant, what should we see as the unique role and responsibility of the elders of IDC? In what ways do the members have similar, but different responsibilities?
