QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. As we pick back up in Song of Songs this week, how have you been encouraged through the study of this book?
 - a. What are some things that you have found challenging in studying this book?
- 2. This week, Pastor Walter tried to explain some of the nuance tied to the interpretation of a dream that is taking place within a metaphor. He suggests this dream relates to the enemy's frustration of the couple's sexual union. In what ways can vs 5:2-6 serve as a warning for both married and unmarried folks?
 - a. Married folks, what does it look like for you to serve your spouse in your sexual relationship?
- 3. Towards the middle of the passage the bride has the opportunity to "remember" her husband (vs 10-16). What stands out to you most from her reflections of him?
 - a. Why is it so hard to be known and loved in today's cultural context?
- 4. In 5:16, the woman praises the man as her "friend." Walter highlighted this point to show that sexual fulfillment is insufficient to hold a relationship together. What else is needed? How do we see these features in other, non-marital relationships? What are some of the non-sexual elements of a healthy relationship that you struggle with?
- 5. As a point of application, Pastor Walter stated that "marriage and relationships are actually a search for Jesus?" What did Pastor Walter mean by this statement?
 - a. What in your life is hindering you from believing this statement?
- 6. Walter encouraged us to "embrace sexual desire as a tutor." How has the Lord taught you through sexual desire, whether fulfilled or unfulfilled?
