QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. ICE BREAKER: What conflicts have you faced or seen others face within the church? How were they resolved?
- 2. What resources do we have to resolve conflict in the church? [leaders, church members, the Word, mind of Christ, Holy Spirit, etc.]
- 3. What is your response when you encounter conflict? Do you seek to resolve it? Do you find it easier to resolve conflict with certain groups of people, but more difficulty with others? What changes do you need to make to love your brothers and sisters better in this area?
- 4. Tony mentioned that Paul wants his readers to align their lives with their identity in Christ. Examine the vice list in verses 9-10. What things do you need to change to better align your life with Christ?
- 5. "Such were some of you." How can we live our lives aligned with Christ when we feel the guilt and shame of our sin?
- 6. Discuss the difference between washed, sanctified, and justified. What is your response to those truths? How is our daily life/worship impacted by these truths?
- 7. In what ways does this passage lead us to gratitude?
- 8. How can our Growth Group work together to say no to sin and live righteous lives?
