QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. Paul made the argument that the stronger believers in this text have more knowledge, but weren't using it well. What were they doing wrong? What is the correct thing to do?
- 2. Paul said that love "builds up." What would it look for Christians to build up one another?
- 3. 8:2 implies our knowledge will always be incomplete. What are the implications of this fact?
- 4. What is the connection between "loving God" and "being known by God?"
- 5. Christians will not always agree on disputable matters. What should we do in these instances? What are some examples of possible differences we may have with our brothers and sisters that could lead to disputes.
- 6. Paul asserts Christian monotheism in a world of polytheism. What does Paul's words about the Father and the Son imply about Christian living?
- 7. Knowledge, conscience, and love are vital concepts for making decisions. How can you use these things to build one another up?
- 8. Where does your GG need to improve in handling disputable matters? What disagreements have had with your group or someone in your group that you need to settle and/or repent of how you handled it?
