QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. ICEBREAKER: What is the weirdest meat or food item you have eaten?
- 2. What are some tough decisions you have had to make before in your life? What steps did you take to make those decisions?
- 3. Paul talks about not just doing what is lawful, but also what is loving. How can this affect our decisions?
- 4. Tony cautioned us to be aware of the effects of our actions on believers. What kinds of things can we do with our freedom to build them up, instead of causing them to sin?
- 5. Tony argued that we may think about our freedoms when around unbelievers too. How might exercising our freedoms be a stumbling block to non-believers?
- 6. Tony said in the sermon that having a meal with an unbeliever seemed to be a regular custom in the New Testament Church. How can you and your GG perhaps make this a part of your evangelism?
- 7. How might we use knowledge, love, and conscience to make good decisions?
- 8. After walking through this text, as well as texts from the past few weeks, how would you define "doing everything to the glory of God?"
- 9. In light of this text, what do you need to do to better relate with fellow believers? Unbelievers?
