- 3. What were the analogies Paul used for the resurrection? Can anyone recall what they mean? In what ways do these analogies lead you to praise God?
- 4. How does the resurrection of our bodies change our grieving of loss? Is it okay to grieve in light of the resurrection?
- 5. How does 1 Corinthians 15 solve our problems of death and despair?
- 6. In what ways does this sermon point us to Jesus?
- 7. How might you have conversations with non-believers about death and despair, and use the truths from this text to preach the gospel?
