QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. ICEBREAKER: What's an example of a “bounce back” story you know of?
2. How does Abram provide an example of repentance?
3. When you fail, do you naturally run further from God, or are you quick to return to God and repent? What truths/passages of scripture do we need to remind ourselves of to come back to the Lord faster?
4. What do we learn about peace-making in Abram and Lot's relationship?
5. Conflict is uncomfortable but can often provide opportunities for growth. In what ways can conflict expose idols, grow us in godliness, and give us opportunities to receive and display grace toward others?
6. Tony said the way in Which Lot and Abram chose their land was different. How so?
7. Lot chose based on his eyes. When he moved there, it got worse. Sin often operates like this. How can we “preemptively” fight sin working against us?
8. In talking about failing, I'm sure our sins are coming to the forefront of our minds. Is there anything you need to repent of?
9. Do you have any conflict your life? What steps do we need to take to resolve this conflict?
10. Abraham bounced back after his failure to trust in the promises of God. In light of our discussions of our failures and the things that we need to repent of, what promises from God do you need to believe this week?
