QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Let's share evidence of the Lord's kindness from the holiday season. Anything that we can praise the Lord for? Anything we need to pray for and encourage you in?
2. What are some contemporary challenges we face in imitating this early Christian community?
3. Which of Luke's 10 ingredients resonated with you? Why?
4. Are you experiencing awe and joy in your Christian life? If yes, how? If not, what are the impediments to that in your life right now (e.g. lack of time, lack of focused pursuit, need for repentance, etc)? Let's take some time to pray for that. Pray to "restore the joy of my salvation," and "to rejoice even in the midst of trial."
5. What are some changes you can make and steps you can take to address some of these weaknesses personally?
6. What is the biggest obstacle standing between you and deep, genuine relationships with other believers?
7. Do you think outsiders observing IDC would be attracted to the faith because of IDC? Why or why not?
8. The passage this week showed how the early church devoted themselves to the Word and prayer. We also just heard two great sermons on this subject from Walter and Akeloe. What steps are you taking in 2025 to more fully devote yourself to the study of the Scriptures and prayer?
