## **QUESTIONS**

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. What are some brief things we can say to remind us about the narrative so far, and the things we've learned along the way?
- 2. Isaac let his cravings rule his decision-making process. In what ways are we tempted to do the same? How can we fight and not let cravings distort our spiritual lives?
- 3. The biblical account here describes no heroes, no examples to follow, and no one perceived as innocent. What can be learned from such an account?
- 4. One lesson from this text is on both the pervasiveness of sin and the effects of sin. What effects does sin have? Who and what does our sin have consequences on?
- 5. The biblical narrative is a "chaotic mess" as Tony points out in his sermon title. In what ways do we find hope in this passage?
- 6. "God's purposes cannot be frustrated by human failure." In what ways is this encouraging to you? In what ways do you struggle to believe this?
- 7. Tony said one way to respond to this text was gratitude. In what ways should we be thankful in response to this narrative?
