QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

- 1. Joseph has gone from the pit to the place, a prison cell to the royal court, and from prison clothes to the apparel of rulers. This biblical account is meant to encourage us in God's ability to transform situations. Share with the group times when God has provided in such ways.
- 2. Tony said that we should live with a big vision of God. What does this look like? What does a "big view" of God do for us?
- 3. The Joseph narrative shows us that God blesses His people with wisdom. Where can we find this wisdom?
- 4. After he interprets the dreams, Joseph declares God is sovereign over all these events, now you need to plan to make it happen. What does the balance of God's sovereignty and human responsibility look like day to day?
- 5. God's sovereignty should keep us from despair, but not from passionate work. How might God's sovereignty motivate us to "keep up the work?"
- 6. Pharaoh was pleased with Joseph's word about God. Tony used this moment to talk about how God can be sovereignly working in the people who we want to proclaim our faith to. How might this give us confidence in our evangelism? Let's take some moments now to pray for those who are lost. Ask God to work in their hearts, and ask God to give us confidence.
